HEALTH CARE SUMMARY

Upon enrollment, or within 30 days, a medical record of each child must be submitted to the Director. It must include a current examination and must be signed by each child's source of medical care. A record of physical examination is again required annually for children under 24 months of age and whenever a child 24 months or older advances to an older age group.

IMMUNIZATIONS

Upon enrollment, documentation of current immunizations must be submitted. For inadequate or unimmunized children, a signed, notarized statement of parental objection to the immunization or medical exemption is required.

INADEQUATELY IMMUNIZED CHILDREN

If a case of measles, mumps, rubella, pertussis, polio, or diphtheria occurs in the child care setting, children who are inadequately or incompletely immunized will be excluded throughout the incubation period of the last reported case of the disease, as determined by local health officials. This exclusion is necessary because these children may become infected and contribute to further disease spread. This exclusion also applies to children who have not been immunized for conscientiously held beliefs or medical contraindications. **When documentation exists that a child is unimmunized on the basis of personal beliefs rather than a medical condition, a program can refuse to enroll the child.**
